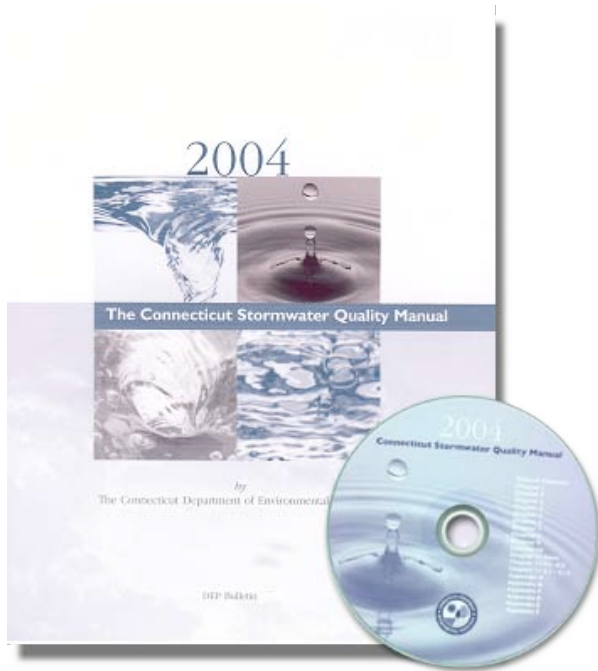


A CTASLA AND CCAPA JOINT EVENT

The CT Stormwater Quality Manual: new guidance for stormwater practice



The Connecticut Stormwater Quality Manual provides guidance on the measures necessary to protect the waters of the State of Connecticut from the adverse impacts of stormwater runoff. This new manual focuses on site planning, source control and treatment practices. It is intended for use as a planning tool and design guidance document for both the regulated and regulatory communities involved in stormwater quality management.

This workshop will focus on those parts of the manual of interest to landscape architects and planners. In particular, the training will focus on the importance of site design, innovative approaches to stormwater management, effectiveness of various stormwater treatment practices and how to size and design these practices. Workshop content is approved subject matter for CEUs for landscape architects. All participants will receive a copy of the CT Stormwater Quality Manual.

Educational workshops on the manual will be conducted by a team from CT DEP, University of CT NEMO Program and Fuss & O'Neill, Inc.
